

Arthur R. van der Vant – Illinois Receiver

Since 2010 Arthur R. van der Vant has been serving as a Receiver in Illinois State Courts, the Third Judicial Circuit Court of Michigan, and in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division. Arthur is an Associate Member of the Chicago Bar Association (CBA).

Arthur earned the prestigious Certified Auctioneers Institute Member (CAI) designation from the National Auctioneers Association Education Institute, representing three years of graduate-level curriculum, and he was also confirmed by the National Auctioneers Association as an Accredited Auctioneer of Real Estate (AARE). Illinois Licensed Auctioneer (2008-2012).

Arthur was designated as a CCIM by the Commercial Investment Real Estate Institute. The CCIM designation is earned upon completion of a graduate-level curriculum and attainment of a high level of qualifying experience. CCIMs are recognized experts in commercial and investment real estate throughout the world. Arthur also has been recognized as a member of the Hall of Fame of the National Association of Realtors – RPAC, and he has earned many real estate industry designations and certifications, such as: CCIM, CAI, AARE, PRI, CNE, CIPS, CRB, CRS, GRI, ABR, RECS, SRES, and ePRO.

Arthur served as the President of the Illinois CCIM Chapter (2005); Vice President of the Illinois CCIM Chapter (2004); Treasurer of the Illinois CCIM Chapter (2003); and the Board Member and Director of the Illinois CCIM Chapter (2000-2008), as well as, a Director and a Board Member of the Chicago Association of Realtors (2002-2004).

Arthur participated in management and liquidation of approximately 10,000 assets throughout North America and Europe for courts, financial institutions, corporations, and individuals. Prior to his work as a receiver, Arthur owned and operated: Real Estate Brokerage Company, Mortgage Company, Title Insurance Company, and Construction & Development Company.

Real Estate Brokerage (1988-2010) – Owned and operated a real estate brokerage company that he grew from 6 agents to 612 sales associates. His company ranked among the top 10 real estate brokerages in the State of Illinois with an average of 200 closed transactions per month and annual sales of approximately \$1 Billion Dollars.

Mortgage Company (2005-2009) – Arthur owned and supervised an Illinois Mortgage Banking Company and has been involved in all aspects of loan origination and underwriting.

Title Insurance (1998-2004) – Arthur owned and operated a title insurance agency for six years, performed title examination, conducted closings, and supervised all aspects of title insurance agency's operations.

Construction & Development (1991-2008) – Arthur is familiar with all aspects of construction and development. He owned and operated a union construction company where he increased revenue by approximately 300% within 6 months of his acquisition of the shareholder interest. Arthur engaged in building and development of condominiums in Lincoln Park area of Chicago and acted as a general contractor.
